Clay County Utility Authority Disability Assistance Plan Extended Payment Plan for Our Permanently Disabled Customers

Clay County Utility Authority's *Disability Assistance Plan* is a special extended payment plan which provides eligible customers an extra 21 days to pay their utility bill without penalty. The plan takes into consideration that customers may receive Social Security or disability checks on a date that does not coincide with the due date of their current utility bill. To qualify for the plan, a customer must meet <u>all</u> of the following requirements:

- > Permanently disabled
- > On a limited, fixed income

If payment is not received by the extended date, a late charge of \$3.00 or 1½% of the delinquent amount (whichever is greater) will be added. The account will then be issued to our service department for collection or disconnection.
