CCUA Assists Sarasota County Following Hurricane Milton

CCUA Deploys Crews to Respond to Storm Impacts



MIDDLEBURG, Fla., October 15, 2024 – The Clay County Utility Authority (CCUA) is assisting Sarasota County following the devastating impacts from Hurricane Milton. CCUA deployed more than twenty (20) staff members and dozens of vehicles to assist with disaster response efforts in the area. Our crews left early in the morning on Sunday, October 13, 2024, with a convoy of equipment to assist a community in their time of need.

"Our team wants to help communities respond to natural disasters like Hurricane Milton. One day, we will need their help. We take great pride in being part of the State of Florida's response to hurricanes that impact our fellow communities", said CCUA's Executive Director, Jeremy Johnston.

The CCUA team has repeatedly deployed to assist communities in need after disasters. CCUA has participated in disaster responses going back to the early 2000's. More recently, CCUA deployed highly trained professionals to support disaster response efforts after Hurricanes Ian, Idalia, and Helene.
